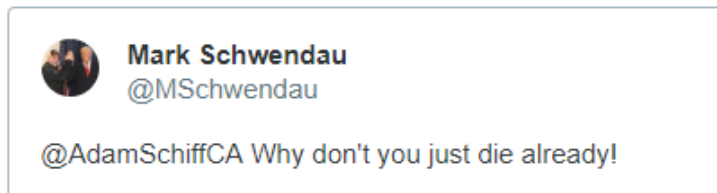
Hello Mark Schwendau,
